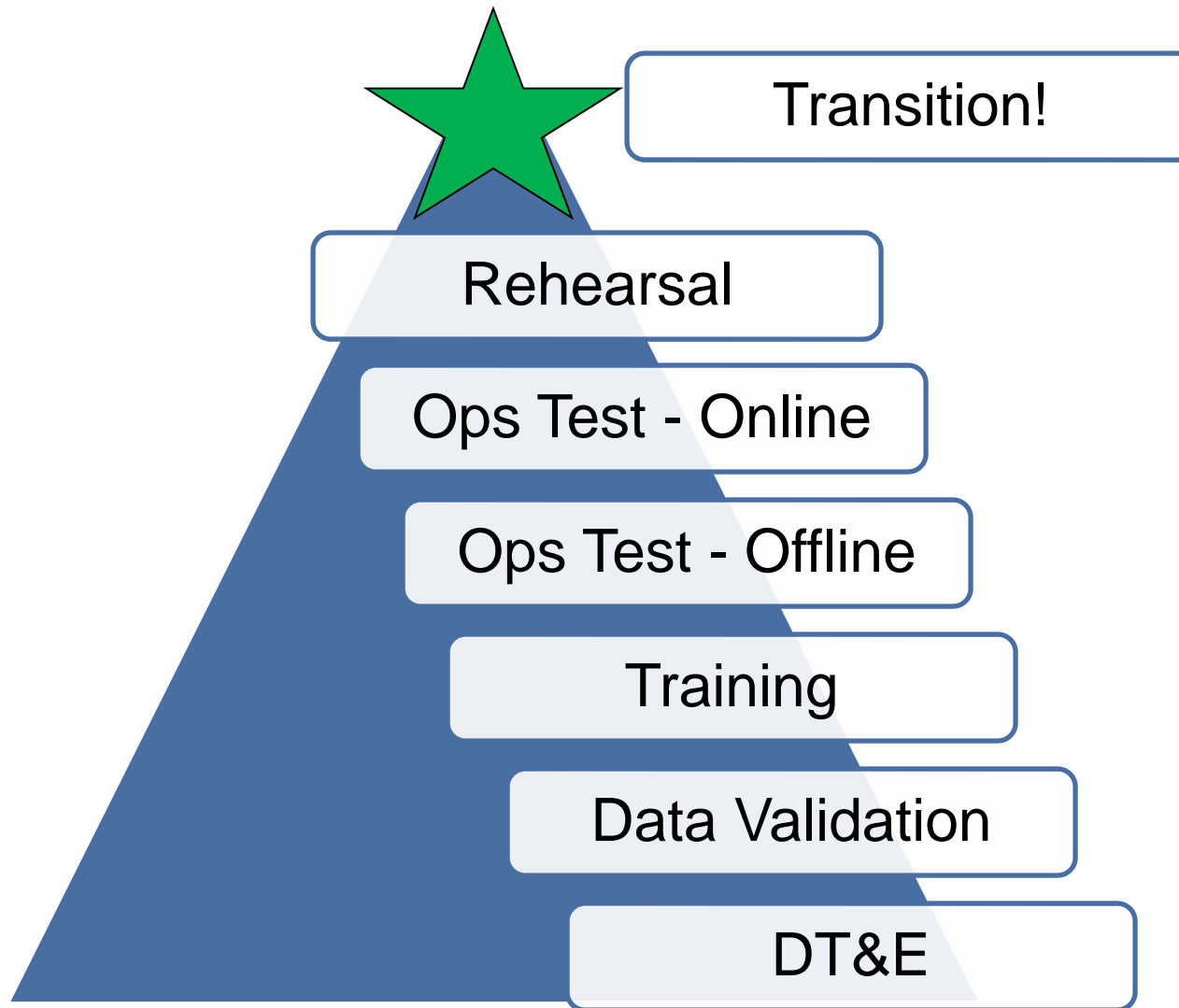

Transition Overview

- Change of State
- Purpose of system development is to ultimately put it into operations
 - *End state should be considered throughout the acquisition and development process*
 - *User/Operator is the customer, regardless of impetus for the change*
- Proper consideration and planning for transition can greatly simplify its execution

Transition Confidence Pyramid



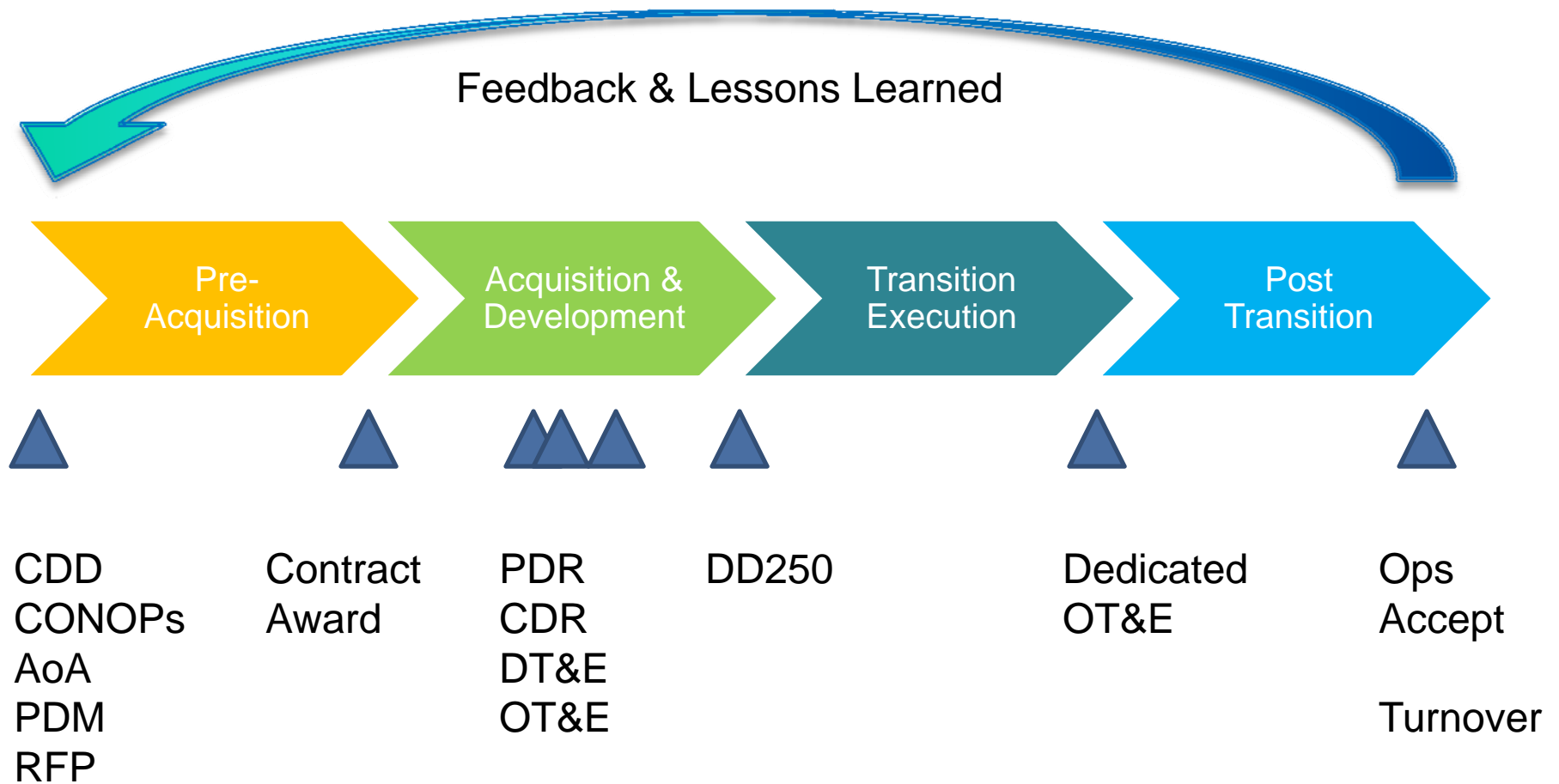
Elements of Transition

- Readiness & Test
 - *TD Assignment*
 - *Confidence Pyramid*

 - *Manning*
 - *Training*
- Approvals, Communication & Coordination
 - *Comm Strategy*
 - *Accreditation*
 - *Turnover*
 - *Ops Accept*

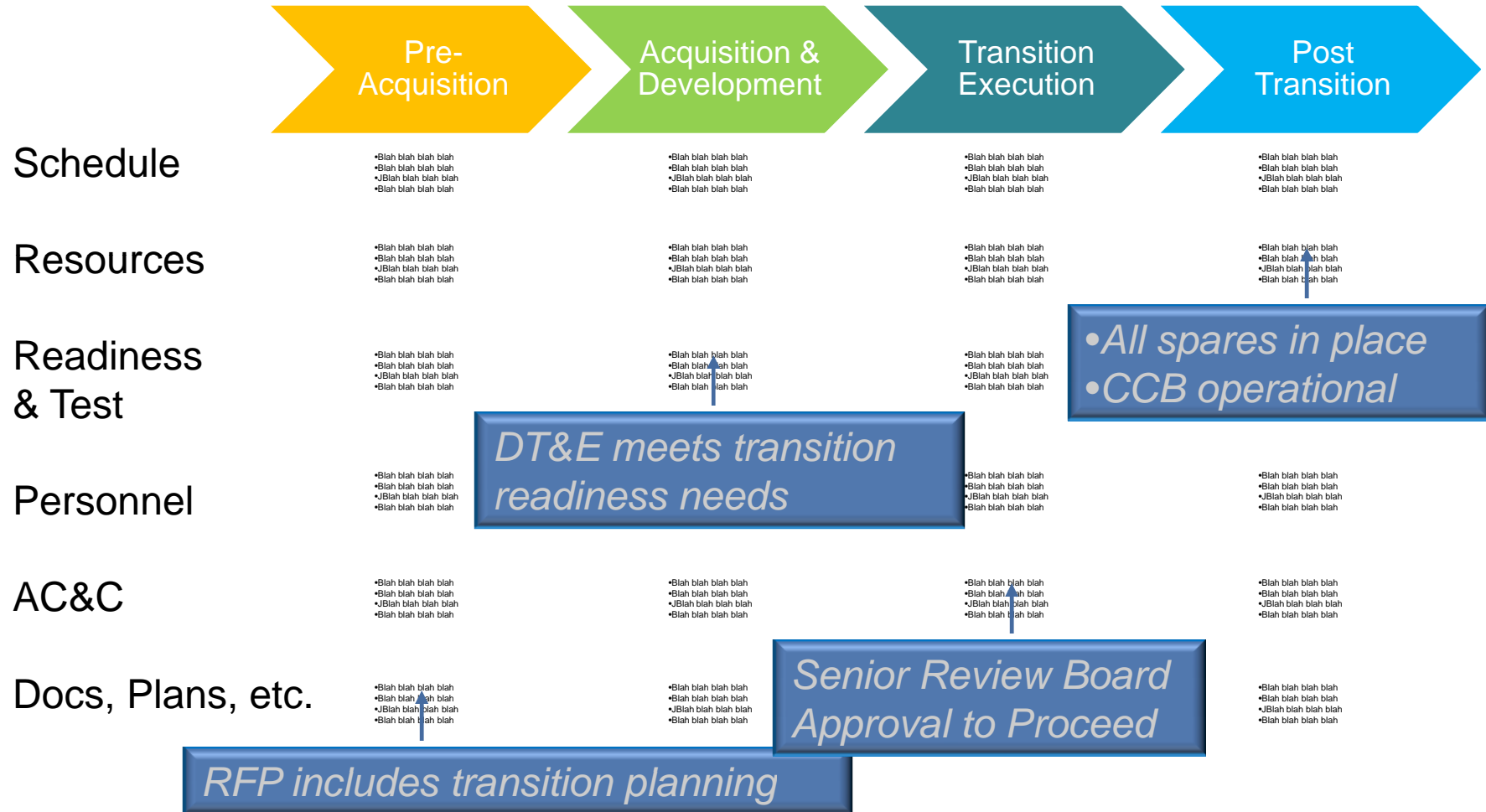
Elements of Transition (cont)
