

## Jay Santee



Jay G. Santee is currently a General Manager at the office of senior vice president, Defense Systems Group at The Aerospace Corporation. Santee served 33 years in the United States Air Force, retiring as a major general in 2014. Santee's key assignments include as deputy director of the Defense Threat Reduction Agency, acting deputy assistant Secretary of Defense for Space Policy, vice commander of the 14th Air Force, Director of the Space Operations Center (now the Combined Space Operations Center), commander of the 21st Space Wing, and operations division chief at U.S. Space Command. Prior to joining Aerospace, Santee was outcome leader for Resilient Affordable Space at MITRE, where he was responsible for directing and shaping MITRE's contributions to the national security space enterprise's fielding of a resilient, affordable space force. At the Aerospace Corporation, Santee was the vice president, Strategic Space Operations, Defense Systems Group, provided supports to the U.S. Space Command, HQ U.S. Space Force, Space Operations Command, Space Training and Readiness Command, the Space Warfare Analysis Center, the Space Security and Defense Program, the Department of the Air Force Rapid Capabilities Office, the Space Rapid Capability Office, the Air Force Research Laboratory, and Project West Wing and the Innovation and Prototyping Directorate of the Space and Missile Systems Center (Space Systems Command shortly) Development Corps.
