Lt Col Jeffrey Newcamp is Associate Professor and Director of the Systems Engineering Program at the United States Air Force Academy, Colorado. Prior to this assignment, he served as Deputy Commander of the 96th Operations Group, Eglin AFB, Florida. There he was responsible for approximately 800 personnel assigned to eight diverse units performing flight and ground test operations across six geographically separated sites. Lt Col Newcamp oversaw planning, execution and reporting for thousands of USAF conventional munitions and operational flight program tests on F-15, F-16, A-10, UH-1, HH-60, MH-139, CV-22, C-130, AWACS and Big

Safari aircraft. Lt Col Newcamp is a Test Pilot School graduate, holds three masters degrees and earned his PhD in Aerospace Engineering from the Delft University of Technology in the Netherlands. He has flown over 35 aircraft types.
